


## "INSTRUMENTS OF NIGHT"



TIME: "INSTRUMENTS OF NIGHT" IS SET IN 1983, DURING THE REAGAN ERA. THIS WAS A TIME OF RAMPANT CRIME IN NEW YORK CITY. IT WAS ALSO BEFORE LAW ENFORCEMENT HAD THE ABILITY TO ANALYZE DNA EVIDENCE, AND BEFORE WIDESPREAD USE OF CELL PHONES OR PERSONAL COMPUTERS. THERE ARE OCCASIONAL FLASHBACKS TO OTHER PLACES AND TIMES.

PLACE: THE STORY IS SET MOSTLY IN NEW YORK CITY IN 1983, AND AT AN ISOLATED OLD ESTATE/MANSION CALLED RIVERWOOD IN THE FICTIONAL COMMUNITY OF BRITTANY FALLS IN UPSTATE NEW YORK. THERE WILL BE OCCASIONAL FLASHBACKS TO A SMALL FAMILY FARM IN NORTH CAROLINA IN 1962, TO RIVERWOOD IN 1946, AND TO MANHATTAN IN 1901 FOR IMAGINED SCENES FROM PAUL'S EDWARDIAN MYSTERY NOVELS. ONE SCENE WILL TAKE PLACE ON A CLIFF OVERLOOKING SOMETHING SIMILAR TO NIAGARA FALLS ("BRITTANY FALLS").

#### MAIN CHARACTERS:

PAUL GRAVES (30S), A TROUBLED BUT BRILLIANT BEST-SELLING MYSTERY NOVELIST. HE'S A SELF-DESTRUCTIVE LONER WHO IS TORMENTED BY HIS WORST SECRET: HE PLAYED A MAJOR (INVOLUNTARY) ROLE IN HIS TEEN SISTER GWEN'S MURDER WHEN HE WAS !2. PAUL CHANNELS HIS HORRIFIC MEMORIES OF HER MURDER INTO HIS BOOKS, AND IS LITERALLY HAUNTED BY HIS OWN FICTIONAL CHARACTERS. HIS SAVING GRACE: HE'S ACTUALLY A GOOD MAN-- IF ONLY HE KNEW IT.

ELEANORA SANCHEZ (LATINA; 20S), PAUL'S INCISIVE, SEXY AND FREE-SPIRITED LOVE INTEREST AND CLEVER CO-DETECTIVE IN SOLVING FAYE'S MURDER. A MYSTERY PLAYWRIGHT, SHE IS DETERMINED TO UNCOVER EVERYONE'S SECRETS-- INCLUDING HIS. SHE SENSES THAT PAUL IS A GOOD MAN DESPITE HIS MYSTERIOUS MOOD SWINGS.

DETECTIVE SLOVAK (50S): A FIGMENT OF PAUL'S IMAGINATION: THE WITTY NEW YORK POLICE DETECTIVE WHO IS THE HERO OF PAUL'S EDWARDIAN (CIRCA 1901) MYSTERY NOVELS, AND IS PAUL'S CONSCIENCE AND ALTER EGO. SLOVAK PURSUES KESSLER, THE MORIARTY-LIKE VILLAIN IN ALL OF PAUL'S MYSTERY NOVELS.

KESSLER (40S): PAUL'S FICTIONAL PSYCHOPATHIC VILLAIN, WHO APPEARS IN PAUL'S LIFE AS A DEVILISH APPARITION, TAUNTING AND TEMPTING HIM, PLAYING ON HIS GUILT AND TRYING TO CONVINCE HIM HE'S A KILLER AT HEART. PAUL BASED KESSLER ON THE REAL-LIFE KILLER WHO FORCED HIM TO HANG HIS SISTER.

There are also major supporting roles in "instruments of night" for <mark>Jessica Suzuki (10)</mark> Paul's asian american neighbor in manhattan; <mark>gwen</mark> and <mark>faye</mark>, the two teenage girls whose deaths are central to this story; paul's agent, <mark>morty</mark>, plus <mark>allison davies</mark> and all the dangerous murder suspects in faye's killing: the entire dysfunctional <mark>davies family</mark> at riverwood, and their 50s).

#### ABOUT THE WRITERS

STATON RABIN IS AN AWARD-WINNING SCREENWRITER WHO ALSO WRITES NOVELS FOR SIMON & SCHUSTER, INCLUDING THE HIGHLYACCLAIMED <u>BETSY AND THE EMPEROR</u>, WHICH IS PUBLISHED IN 15 LANGUAGES GLOBALLY AND WAS PREVIOUSLY OPTIONED FOR A
MOVIE ALONG WITH HER SCREENPLAY--- AS REPORTED IN "VARIETY". HER RECENT SCREEN ADAPTATION OF ALEX
ROSENBERG'S NOVEL THE GIRL FROM KRAKOW WAS WRITTEN ON ASSIGNMENT FOR PRODUCERS
TONY GREENBERG AND MIKE SAMMACICCIA.

PRIOR TO BECOMING A FULL-TIME SCREENWRITER, MS. RABIN WAS A FREELANCE STORY ANALYST FOR WARNER BROS. PICTURES, NEW LINE CINEMA, AND THE FORMER WILLIAM MORRIS AGENCY. SHE HAS BEEN A FREQUENT GUEST SPEAKER FOR SCREENWRITING CLASSES AT NYU, FROM WHICH SHE RECEIVED HER BFA IN FILM. AS A SCREENPLAY DEVELOPMENT CONSULTANT AND FREELANCE EDITOR, SHE'S WORKED FOR NUMEROUS WRITERS, PRODUCERS, AND DIRECTORS, AND HAS TAUGHT SCREENWRITING OCCASIONALLY AT NYU, AS WELL AS FOR CUNARD AND HUDSON VALLEY WRITERS' CENTER. SHE IS REPRESENTED BY LEYLA KADER DAHM OF ZERO GRAVITY MANAGEMENT.

THOMAS H. COOK (B. 1947) -- AUTHOR OF THE NOVEL <u>INSTRUMENTS OF NIGHT</u> THAT IS THE BASIS FOR RABIN'S LIMITED TV SERIES-- HAS WRITTEN NEARLY TWO DOZEN CRITICALLY LAUDED CRIME NOVELS. BORN IN FORT PAYNE, ALABAMA, COOK PUBLISHED HIS FIRST NOVEL, BLOOD INNOCENTS, IN 1980 WHILE SERVING AS THE BOOK REVIEW EDITOR OF ATLANTA MAGAZINE. TWO YEARS LATER, ON THE RELEASE OF HIS SECOND NOVEL, THE ORCHIDS, HE TURNED TO WRITING FULL-TIME. COOK PUBLISHED STEADILY THROUGH THE 1980S, PENNING SUCH WORKS AS THE FRANK CLEMONS TRILOGY, A SERIES OF MYSTERIES STARRING A JADED COP. HE FOUND BREAKOUT SUCCESS WITH THE CHATHAM SCHOOL AFFAIR (1996), WHICH WON AN EDGAR AWARD FOR BEST NOVEL. HIS WORK HAS BEEN PRAISED BY CRITICS FOR HIS ATTENTION TO PSYCHOLOGY AND THE LYRICAL NATURE OF HIS PROSE. BESIDES MYSTERIES, COOK HAS WRITTEN TWO TRUE-CRIME BOOKS, EARLY GRAVES (1992) AND THE EDGAR-NOMINATED BLOOD ECHOES (1993), AS WELL AS SEVERAL LITERARY NOVELS, INCLUDING ELENA (1986).
