JENELLE RILEY *WRITER*

Jenelle Riley is a three-time Emmy Award winner for her work as writer/producer/host of PBS' **Actors on Actors**. She frequently hosts the SAG-AFTRA Foundation Conversations, where she has moderated career retrospectives with such artists as Angelina Jolie, Leonardo DiCaprio, and Viola Davis. The series has been viewed over 12 million times on YouTube. She wrote the award-winning short film **Warning Labels**, directed by Jennifer Morrison and starring Karen Gillan and Rose McIver. Other short films include the Palm Springs Film Festival Best of Fest Winner **Crazy Love**, **The Perfect Candidate**, and **Grand Gestures**.

She won the L.A. Weekly Theatre Award for writing and directing **A Kind of Love Story**, which has been published by Dramatists Inc. and performed in three countries. Other plays include **Jane Austen's Emma Frankenstein**, **Heart Murmurs and Brain Matter**, and **Comfortably Numb**. She spent 12 years as the Awards and Features Editor at Variety, where she oversaw several **10 to Watch** programs, recognizing such early talent as Greta Gerwig, Mahershala Ali, and Glen Powell.



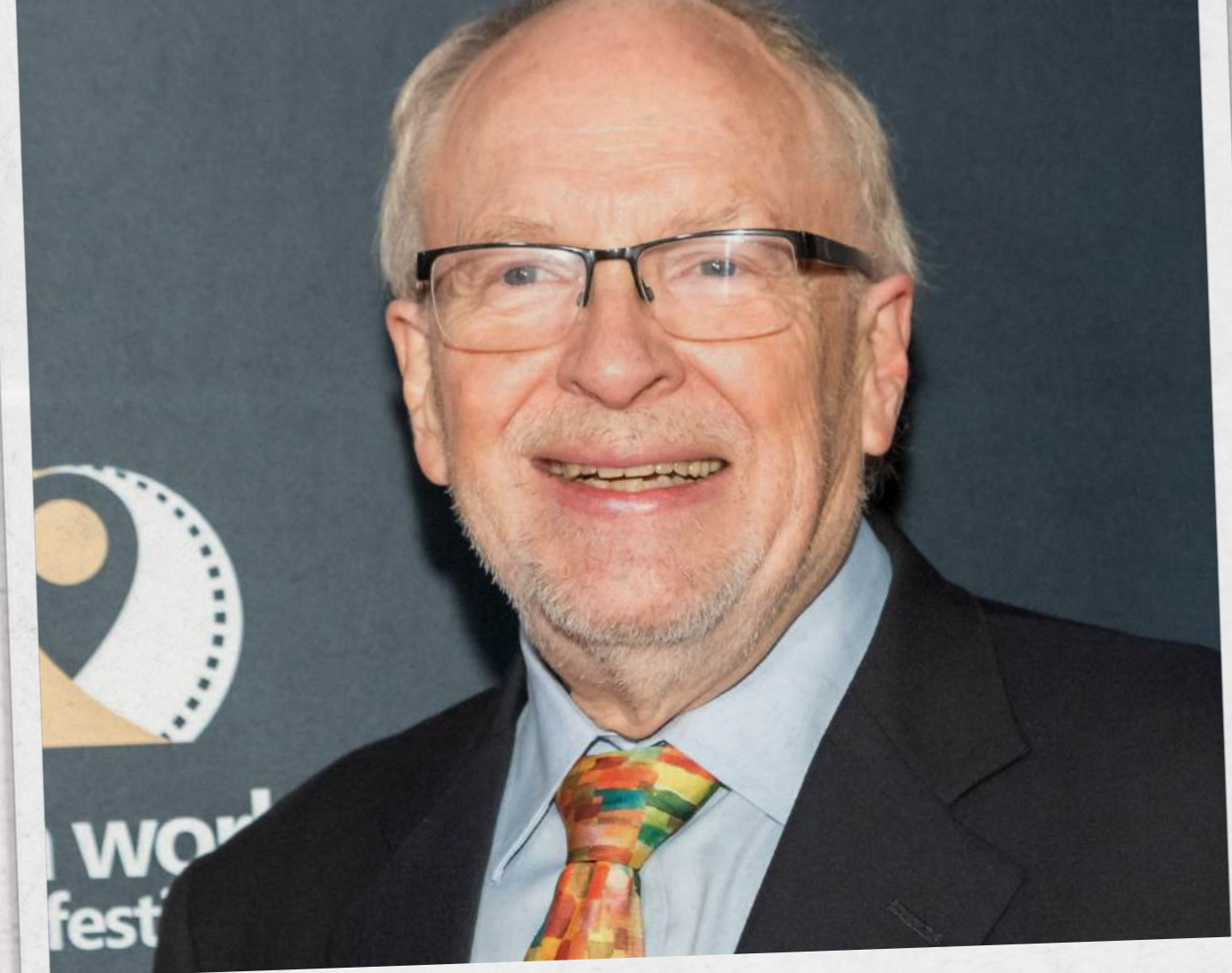
JULES BRUFF

Jules Bruff is an actress, writer, and producer whose work is rooted in character-driven independent storytelling. Her feature **Good Side of Bad**, which she co-wrote, produced, and starred in, opened Dances With Films Los Angeles, went on to win multiple festival awards, and is now streaming across platforms. She previously wrote, produced, and starred in the award-winning feature **Part Time Fabulous**, and is currently attached to produce **Ex Life**, **Coyote**, **Station Zero**, and **Jacob**. She began her producing career as an Associate Producer on **Illusion**, the final film of screen legend Kirk Douglas, directed by Michael Goorjian and co-starring Bryan Cranston.
